

Action Plan & Health Research (to March'15) 2014/15 Cheshire HNA implementation programme



Overview

Following the release of a health needs assessment (HNA) of offenders in the community in summer 2013, Cheshire Constabulary and NHS partners subsequently funded essential follow-on work - a recommendation implementation programme, from October 2013 to April 2015.

The present HNA action planning focuses upon 16 recommendations, including mental health, personality disorder and substance misuse actions.

Cheshire Constabulary have agreed to fund research support for 18 months, to ensure that HNA recommendations continue to have a sound, contemporary evidence base, supported by the latest research.

Key objectives are:

- To directly support the Warrington Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) project lead to progress the 16 recommendations from the HNA of offenders report.
- To help link together the necessary offender-related research, information and intelligence ‘building blocks’ that form the foundations for the delivery of many health and wellbeing related objectives for Cheshire partners.

- Action plan development and monitoring, to prioritise recommendations.
