<u>Please note</u>: Parking and registration is not at the Force Headquarters - it is at the Tactical Training Centre (TTC) which is located behind the Head Quarters building. Access to the TTC is via Barlow Drive, off Browning Way. From the A54 (Oakmere Rd) roundabout, take the Browning Way exit – and the first right off Browning Way is Barlow Drive. Once on Barlow Drive, continue past Rolls-Royce and the rear entrance to the force HQ on the right, to a mini roundabout. At roundabout turn right to TTC ('A' on map).
