RE: Appreciative Inquiry of Community Nursing for Children and Young People – Summative Event

As you are aware NHS South Cheshire, NHS Vale Royal and NHS Eastern Cheshire Clinical Commissioning Groups are working together to better understand the current community nursing support provided in their areas to Children and Young People with treatment needs.

This work has commenced with a 6-week period of engagement delivered by two external, independent consultants; Michael Lloyd Research and VoiceBox Inc, using an appreciative inquiry approach.

This will also be an opportunity for us to share with you our anticipated next steps for this work and how we propose to continue these conversations with you, as part of ongoing planning, commissioning and delivery of local services.

We are reviewing Children's and Young People's community nursing to ensure service provision meets the needs of individuals and families and to look at how we can improve this provision for the future. We want to continue to work with you to develop these plans over the next 6-months and therefore look forward to speaking with you again at one of the summative events.

We will contact you again towards the end of August/early September to confirm details of the venue and the programme.
