What we have responsibility for

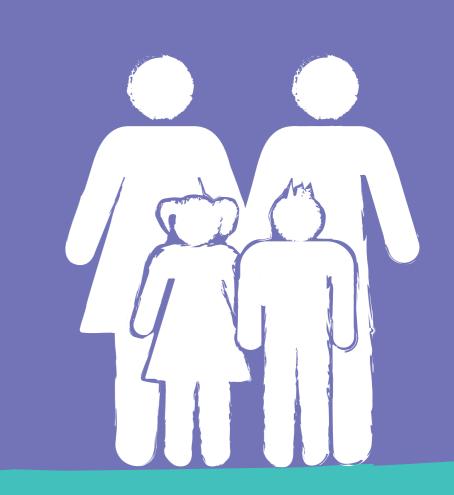
- Health visiting (from October 2015)
