
Yorkshire's Back Garden Mapping and Analysis of Natural Heritage

Heritage Lottery Fund



Overview

Yorkshire's Back Garden (YBG) is a Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) campaign highlighting awareness of Yorkshire and the Humber's landscapes and wildlife - and helping local people to connect with them.

MLR has been commissioned by HLF Yorkshire and the Humber team to analyse the distribution of grant funding on natural heritage projects, to inform the YBG initiative. Annual and six-monthly updates are being provided in 2016/17.

What we did

The May 2016 reporting analysed the 227 grants awarded between 1995 and end of 2015, totaling more than £125m. A six-monthly update was supplied in September 2016.

Analysis of trends and patterns of distribution is presented in the reporting for local authority areas, in addition to temporal analysis. An interactive map of grant locations is available on the website developed for this project. See graphic above.

- The reporting shows commissioners how and when grants have been distributed since 1995, and help visualise areas that have benefitted most from grant support.
